Canoe Day at Camp Ledgewood and Camp Sugarbush

GSNEO hosted Canoe Day at Camp Ledgewood and Camp Sugarbush, supported with generous funding from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. Girls who have limited access to water were taught watercraft safety and boating skills. The goal was to increase girls' comfort levels with watercraft and introduce them to new outdoor activities. This past summer, over 50 girls attend Canoe Day from Trumbull and Cuyahoga counties. Girls learned important boating safety skills, like proper fitting for a lifejacket and how to enter and exit boats properly. The girls also practiced new paddling techniques, played boating games, swam, made a boating craft, and tried archery! Donor Spotlight

AmeriCorps NCCC 2021

GSNEO was chosen through a competitive process to enter into partnership with the AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC). This is a federal, team-based national service program for young adults between the ages of 18 and 24, who serve a full-time ten-month term on projects in five main service areas. During the summer of 2021, GSNEO hosted three teams of young people for ten weeks at Camp Ledgewood, Sugarbush, and Timberlane on environmental stewardship projects.

The teams made improvements and renovations that reached every part of the camps. They cleared trails, repaired features, and cleaned, painted, and repaired buildings. They chopped thousands of pounds of firewood, built and repaired picnic tables, and installed dozens of hiking steps and cleared ditches. They renovated and constructed hiking trails and repaired and replaced trail signs. They made improvements and repairs on administration and housing buildings and cleaned and repaired a swimming pool. They painted roofs and exteriors, removed underbrush, and constructed a 56-foot aluminum bridge. They also cleared space for a new gas line. The teams learned about safety, hand tools, collaboration, and large tools. They also learned about natural resource management, renewable and nonrenewable resources, and the importance and/or difficulty of effectively managing them. Most importantly team members learned about Girl Scouts and the benefits of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience. They saw how our camps are a transformative experience for our girls and an integral part of creating girls of courage, confidence, and character, who make the world a better place.

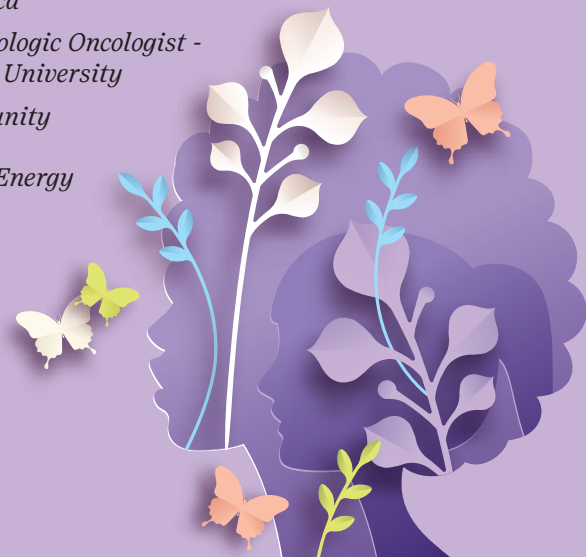
